For Level 6 the High score award goes to the Women's Pair 12-13 from West Coast Training Center of Sabrina Jackson-Kimball & Emilia Kok with a score of 18.267.

For Level 7 the High score award goes to the Mixed Pair 12-13 from West Coast Training Center of Ashley-Nicole Kok & Nikko Leber with a score of 26.300.
