

Acrobatic Gymnastics Scoring System Fees 2017 Season

Two packages of support are offered for acrobatic scoring service:

1. Meet planning and documentation

Services provided include download of online registration through USA Gymnastics site, meet planning in accordance with meet director's preferences (if desired) and rotation order setup.

The following items are included with this package:

Online Meet Registration with USAG membership verification

Session and Rotation Order planning

Acrobat PDF files of:

- Rotation and schedule for pre-meet distribution to clubs
- Athlete participation listing and program rotation for printed programs
- Meet Planning reports including:
 - Participating club listing, medal counts, entry fees, pair group counts, club rosters and tariff sheet listing
- Meet Execution reports including:
 - Judges score slips, Announcers Rotation, Timer's Rotation, Height Measurement collection, Manual Score sheets
- Optional Microsoft Excel spreadsheet for Score Entry & Display

Online scores posted after the meet

What the Meet Director Needs to Provide:

Communication with the clubs and judges

Creation of the event in the online registration system

Schedule preferences and judging panel information to establish the rotation orders

Printing and distribution of meet materials

Optional computer / Projector and cabling for score Entry & Display

Meet results data in electronic format (ID numbers; score details for each routine)

This package does not provide any supervision, computer equipment, software or other direct competition support.

2. Automated Scoring System

In addition to the items in the “Meet planning and documentation” package, the Automated Scoring System package includes a single meet software license for the scoring system, remote entry terminals and MP3 player applications, computer equipment, supplies and a qualified supervisor to oversee the setup and operation of the scoring system.

The following additional items are included with this package:

Onsite Scoring supervisor

Portable computer scoring equipment:

- Score Entry - Meet Reports - Video projector & cables - Network equipment
- Appeals - Music Player - Laser printer & paper - Power cables

Electronic Laser tool for Height Measurement

Announcer microphone, mixer & cables

Labels for Medals (1-²/₃” diameter)

Stopwatch and clipboard for timer

What the Meet Director Needs to Provide:

Communication with the clubs

Creation of the event in the online registration system

Overall schedule plans used for establishing the rotation orders

Four 6’ banquet tables & six chairs for scoring equipment and operators

Screen for projecting the scores (a clean white wall may work)

CD player, audio power amplifier, speakers, floor monitors & cabling

Judges supplies (pencils, notepads, etc.) Note: Judging slips will be provided

Volunteers: 1 Runner

1 Timer (reports provided with equipment)

1 Awards supervisor to apply stickers and coordinate distribution

1 Music Operator (reports provided with equipment)

1 Announcer (reports provided with equipment)

* Does not include any travel and hotel expenses for the system supervisor, as applicable.

Travel costs are billed at the current U.S. General Services Administration rate for privately owned automobiles. The supervisor will need to arrive 2 hours prior to the doors opening for setup. If they must leave San Jose prior to 6:00 A.M. they may need to spend the night before the start of the meet. The number of hotel nights required will be determined based on the schedule of the meet.

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
