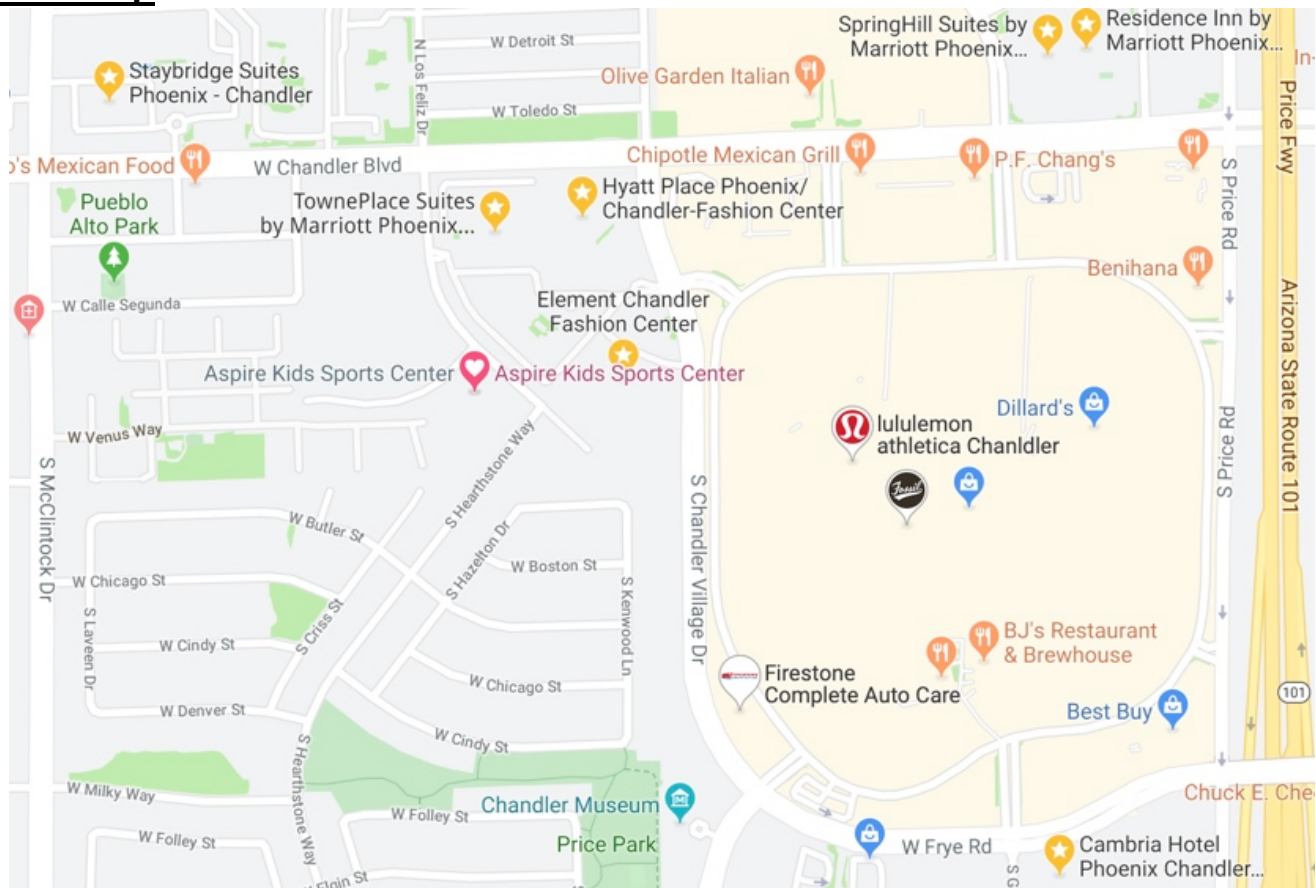

Hybrid Venue/COVID Policies Information Sheet

We are pleased to offer a Hybrid meet format this year and hope it will enable as many of our Region 1 athletes to participate as possible! We are working hard to ensure a smooth and efficient process for all attendees, regardless of location. For those attending in person, we will be implementing all COVID related protocols required by our local governments as well as those that we as the hosting organization believe will help provide the safest environment possible for our athletes, coaches, judges and spectators. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the logistics or protocols listed below, please don't hesitate to reach out to me.

Registration:

- We are limiting the number of *In-Person* Athlete registrations to *100 athletes*. (Based on initial gym tallies plus our gym we are at about 70 in-person athletes. If any additional gyms have interest in sending athletes in person, please reach out to me to confirm if we have yet reached our max.)
- Our sanction is for a regular in-person meet since some of the gyms will be attending in person, but we will follow the Virtual Playbook rules for all groups since we are a hybrid format with virtual participants.
- Online registration through USAG does not specify if your gym will be virtual or in-person, so please email me after your online registration to confirm.

Items to note for a Hybrid format:

- We need an Onsite Coordinator contact for each virtual club competing. I have added this as a new entry line on the registration form.
- We will use Zoom for our virtual platform and will publish the link closer to the event, with rules for competing gyms as well as spectators. Meet schedule, lineup and results page will be shared online as well.
- Each gym with athletes competing virtually needs to ensure:
 - they setup the video for the Zoom per the specs in the Virtual Playbook to livestream their athletes.
 - their audio is setup such that the routine music can be picked up via the Zoom
 - they review the Virtual Playbook for other important details specific to virtual gym sites (https://usagym.org/PDFs/Member%20Services/Sanction/virtualplaybook_acro.pdf)
- The Virtual playbook calls out the following exceptions for Virtual and Hybrid meets:
 - Appeals are not allowed
 - Out of bounds penalties will not be applied
 - Height penalties will not apply
- All competitors in a respective level, event, and age group will be ranked together for awards (across virtual and hybrid events)

COVID Protocols we will follow at the venue:

- Outdoor athlete check-in, with temperature checks
- Outdoor admissions table, with temperature checks and associated athlete confirmation
 - Limit of 2 spectator wristband sales per registered athlete
 - Wristbands are only valid for the sessions specific to that athlete
- Depending on the number of spectators, viewing areas may need to be cleared at the end of each session for sanitizing between sessions and admission of new session spectators per capacity guidelines
- Masks are mandatory at all times for non-athletes
- Masks are mandatory for athletes at all times except when they are competing
 - During warm-ups, athletes will need to wear masks since they will be sharing the floor with other teams' athletes
- In-Person athletes will be limited to no more than 30 per session
- Seating will be setup to ensure social distancing and separation between gyms
